Hello Parents,

The start of a new year – how exciting! Thank you for your support of the Christmas play. Your children were wonderful and everyone enjoyed the mini production. In the next few months I will send out information about our upcoming program in the spring.

This month we will be introducing bible stories and other themes in the curriculum via puppet shows and music. In music class, students are learning tempo as they follow the rhythm of different types of music (a range of slow and fast music). The students have also been exposed to all of the instruments (maracas and castanuelas (Spanish hand held instruments), xylophone, bells, drums, tambourines) among others in the classroom. Now that the children have become familiar with the instruments we will be introducing the keyboard. The older children (4-5 year olds) will have an opportunity to hear and play some notes on the keyboard. In order to enhance our music classroom experience, we have added a puppet stage to tell stories that correlate with our bible themes and monthly themes.

In addition to our music class, Wednesdays we worship together in Kids Room. Parent chapel is held once a month on and we encourage you to join us in worship. Following the parent chapel is a meal that you can enjoy with your child.
